

Useful information after the birth of your baby

Visitors

As a father or co-mother, you are always welcome at the maternity ward, and there is no restriction on how long you can be there. Your own children can visit once a day for an unlimited amount of time.

For other visitors, please refer to our website (www.azdelta.be), which contains the current rules.

As a partner, you may stay overnight in the maternity ward. The charge for this is EUR 25 with breakfast included.

Your presence at night can make a big difference to your wife.

If you are a partner and leave the hospital later than the visiting hours, you must take the night exit (at the emergency department).

No smoking is allowed throughout our hospital, and therefore also the maternity ward. Smoking is only allowed in the designated areas at the hospital reception or in the smoking area at the emergency department.

Registration of your baby's birth

Every Monday, Wednesday and Friday, the municipal registry of the City of Roeselare comes to our hospital.

They are always present from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

This gives you the opportunity to register your baby's birth in our hospital during your stay in the maternity ward.

You need to make an appointment for this. This can be done by telephone on 1788 or via <http://afspraken.roeselare.be>.

The municipal registry is located in room 1.G3.4. This is in the gynaecology consultation corridor. This is the same room where the midwife gave you information during pregnancy.

What should you bring?

- Identity card of both parents
- Name selection form
- Medical birth certificate
- Marriage certificate or Parent certificate

Car park east

You can collect or return your personal belongings in your car via the east entrance. You can park there for half an hour free of charge. Before entering, simply take a ticket at the barrier. If you leave within half an hour, put your parking ticket in the payment terminal at the east entrance. You will receive a ticket for 0 euros.

If you stay longer, you can park in the large visitor car park. Take a ticket, and when you leave, you can put this ticket in a payment terminal and pay.

You can use a shopping cart to load your belongings in and out of your car. Ask your midwife for this. We kindly ask that you always return it to the maternity ward.

Park at the east entrance and take that entrance to the hospital.

Take the long corridor ahead of you to lift B7 on your left.

Go to the 1st floor. When you come out of the lift, the maternity ward is directly to your right.
